First Gold Tour victory for Roberto Turchetto



Gold Tour with obstacles up to 140 cm was third class of Thursdays program. Competition was judged according to the art. 238.2.1. that means against the clock.

Italian representative Roberto Turchetto and Dutch gelding Baronem overcame the highest course of the day with zero penalties in the fastest time 57,10 sec. His compatriot "silver" Fabio Brotto went througth a finish line also without faults and was one and half second slower than winner.

German Thomas Holz in a saddle of mare Chattanooga took third place. Ondřej Zvára was the best home rider. He rode clear round with grey stallion Cardiff Dwerse Hagen Z and occupied sixth place.

Twenty six couples came without penalties and nine of them were from Czech republic. Total sixty seven couples were entered in the first Gold Tour round.



• CSI3*W Olomouc was opened by Silver Tour competition with obstacles up to 130 cm. First winner of the event was Czech Kamil Papoušek on Loki. Aleš Opatrný with Idario Van Het Netehof came on second place and Ladislav Vachutka and Elliot took third place.

• Hanoverian and Dutch warmblood – these are two most succesfull studs, when we look at the TOP10 ranking of CSIYH competition for young horses. Three horses of stud book HANN were places among best ten, the winner including, plus four members of KWPN.

• Total 196 couples competed on Thursday at J&T BANKA CSI3*W Olomouc. The Gold Tour attracted the highest count of participants, 51 riders with 67 horses. Also morning Silver Tour had long starting list. It was overcome by 45 combinations.

• Home riders were most succesfull during first day of CSI3*W Olomouc. Czech national anthem resonated two times and Czechs added also one silver and two bronze positions. Italians played main role at Gold Tour and Poland achieved victory at CSIU25.

This tour is determined to riders up to 25 years and obstacles of first course achieved 140 cm.

Hungarian lady Sára Máriás in a saddle of Cantus Clay came on second place without penalties. Flawless Czech rider Sára Vingrálková with bay gelding Kas-Sini DC took third rank and other home couple Lucie Strnadlová and Fall River Blue VDL was fourth, as she finished without penalties.

Also Japan Kanako Ito came throught with zero, even with two horses Skyliner and Chico, as well as Belgian Rachel Steffen and Hermes. Athlete, who will win the CSIU25 Grand Prix on Saturday, will be qualified at EY Cup 2018 final, that will be held in Salzburg in December.
