## First Grand Prix qualification for Jörne Sprehe



Friday afternoon brought first part of Diamond Tour with obstacles up to 150 cm. The competition against the clock served as qualification for Sundays Grand Prix.

German rider Jörne Sprehe on gelding Solero completed clear round in the best time and won. The ESC arena suits to German Sprehe, she won GP World Cup in 2016 and leads up to next success.

Polish representative Maksymilian Wechta in the saddle of ten years old mare Quinchella finished on second place and Italian rider Roberto Turchetto on bay mare Adare came through a finish line as third.

The best Czech rider Jan Štětina on Verdi S completed flawless round and took tenth position. Two more Czechs finished among TOP15: Zuzana Zelinková with Kleiner Lord and Ondřej Zvára on Quimero M.

## Polish celebration at Friday Gold Tour

Second part of CSI3\*W Olomouc Gold Tour was held on Friday as last competition of day. The course was built in two phases with obstacles up to 145 cm.

Polish representative Michal Kazmierczak in the saddle of mare Helia VD Heihoek completed clear round in the fastest time 25,32 sec. Silver Italian rider Anna Giugno on mare Queen Anne needed more than one second longer time.

Czech rider Jiří Hruška with Acordia MX i2M finished only five hundredths of second slower than Giugno. Also other members of Czech equipe were successful. Nikola Bielíková with bay mare Vepora finished after flawless round on fourth place.

Two more Czechs were among TOP10: Roman Dučač with stallion Dreamer as well as Kateřina Zigová, who participated with mare Ella.



## Sára Vingrálková won a first part of CSIJ

• Juniors competed at CSIJ Olomouc for first time on Friday. Opening class up to 130 cm brought a victory to Sára Vingrálková and Celana Z. Monika Paulauskaite (LTU) with Goeje Vrijdag was second, Polish Aleksandra Kierznowska on Dior V finished on third place.



• Tina Šalková was second Czech winner of Friday at CSI Olomouc. She won EY Cup class with Frascati Van Ter Hulst. Maksymilian Wechta (POL) and Quintus finished on second place, Lithuanian Monika Paulauskaite with Quirados AS took rank no. 3.

• Riders of Czech equipe were successful at CSI3\*W Olomouc during Friday. Czechs collected two „gold“ positions, one second and one third place. Also Polish riders won two times and added second rank twice plus one „bronze“ place.

• Second class of CSIYH for young horses was under control by Polish Hubert Kierznowski on seven years old Qualito Z. Same old Conthaquick with Czech Michaela Rodová took second rank and Sára Máriás (HUN) with six years mare Medall was third.

• Czech riders Anna Kellnerová and Aleš Opatrný, who are members of the Prague Lions team and take part at the prestigious Global Champions series 2018, will be giving out their autographs in Equine Sport Center on Saturday from 12.00 o'clock.
