EMANUELE CAMILLI WON THE CSI3* GRAND PRIX OLOMOUC FEI WORLD CUP 2019

The CSI3* J&T BANKA Olomouc was held from June 19 till June 23. The schedule offered eight tours for juniors, young riders, young horses and also experienced senior riders. Emanuele Camilli won the TOP class Grand Prix Olomouc FEI World Cup.

Grand Prix Olomouc FEI World Cup up to 160 cm by course designer Uliano Vezzani brought luck to Italian athlete Emanuele Camilli on Jakko. He bet five couples at jump-off, thanks to clear and the fastest round. Italian Clementina Grossi and Zquasimodo R came second with zero penalty points, third place belongs to Macedonian Luka Založnik and Chablou.

German star Jörne Sprehe in saddle of Bankimoon won the final of Gold Tour up to 145 cm. Antonio Alfonso from Italy on Dream van Generhese came on second place and Austrian Dieter Köfler with Askaban finished on third position.

Saturday Silver Tour final secured a victory to Czech couple Jakub Štěřba and Go-On T.S., that won already first class of this tour. Dutch rider Sander Geerink on Pandora 258 finished on second place. Polish Jaroslaw Koziarowski with Chennet came third.

Austrian representative Michele Ruth won Grand Prix Czech Equestrian Team with obstacles up to 145 cm for riders U25 and secured direct „ticket“ to the serie European Youngster Cup 2019 final, that will be held in Salzburg in December. She, in the saddle of twelve years chestnut Nathanael, bet three couples in jump-off. Czech rider Kateřina Kubrická and experienced mare Lentilka went also very well. She completed jump-off with four penalty points, and finished on second place. Third position is occupied by Polish athlete Dalia Lehmann in saddle of mare Annchen 11. This couple brought also one fault. Austrian Denise Ruth with gelding Little Joe R came on fourth place with twelve penalty point in jump-off round.

Thirteen couples finished Junior Grand Prix, but only one without penalty points - Czech Anna Helebrantová did it with her horse partner Epo van de Achterhoek Z. Silver got Sára Víngrádková and bronze took Mariana Michlíčková.

Polish athlete Adam Grzegorewski and gelding Issem won final class of CSI Olomouc Youngster Tour for young horses. Next Polish rider Maksymilian Wechta on stallion Callihall took second position. Slovak Patrik Majher with Claude finished on third place.
